TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Registration:

All active participants are required to complete and submit the official registration form and pay an official entry fee. The different attendance fees are listed in our 'Registration Structure and Policy' Document. Please review the document for further details.

Payment and Refunds:

Following the registration confirmation, candidates who register early have 3 working days to pay attendance charges at Edopia (58, Embassy Road, G-6/3, Islamabad). The final **payment deadline is 6th June 2016**. Failure to pay attendance charges within the allotted time will result in cancellation of the candidate's registration.

Please note that the registration fee will not be refunded if a candidate changes his/her mind about participating in the event. Refunds will be provided in the event of sudden event cancellation.

Admission Policy:

A prior Online Registration (either remotely or at the School premises) is a pre-requisite for all candidates wishing to participate in the Summer Workshops. No walk-ins will be entertained at the day of the conference.

Registration Deadline:

All those wishing to register for the Summer Workshops are required to do so before the registration deadline, i.e. 5^{th} June 2015.

Behavior Policy

Event coordinators at Summer Workshops reserve the right to refuse admission to any sessions if a participant or his/her mentor's behavior jeopardizes the safety or learning of other active participants, staff or Workshop representatives. No refund will be forthcoming nor will the Certificate of Attendance be issued.

Certification Policy

Certificates of attendance will be issued only to participants who attend all scheduled sessions throughout the Workshop. Within a week after the event, mentors will be notified via email upon which they can visit the Edopia premises at their earliest convenience to collect the certificates of attendance.

Consent

There is an implied consent that the personal data provided* to Summer Workshops representatives is correct. There is also an implied consent that the active participants allow the organizers to process the given data for registration purposes. All active participants must understand that this information may be made available to representatives and agents working with the organizers to host the Summer Workshops.

* For every participant: first name, last name, e-mail address, contact details, identification information, tracking of all actions performed in the online registration system, record of any communication sent from Summer Workshops. [relevant medical details /information relating to a disability of which Leadathon organizers should be aware, to enable Leadathon organizers to ensure each participant can attend and participate at the conference].
